

AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT
BETWEEN JOINT FORCES STAFF COLLEGE AND
UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND UNIVERSITY COLLEGE

This Amendment to the Agreement between Joint Forces Staff College (JFSC) and University of Maryland University College (UMUC) is made as of August 1, 2006.

RECITALS

- A. JFSC and UMUC are parties to a written agreement entitled "Agreement Between University of Maryland University College and the Joint Forces Staff College" made as of June 1, 2002 (the "Original Agreement").
- B. The parties desire to amend the Original Agreement as set forth herein.

The parties agree as follows:

- 1. Section 1.4 of the Original Agreement is amended and restated in its entirety as follows:

1.4 In addition to the Transferred Credits, Program Participants who wish to pursue the MS in Management Degree must select and complete the core classes and end-of-program classes under the current catalog in effect when student is admitted. The parties agree that UMUC may change the requirements from time to time. A Program Participant must satisfy the requirements in effect at the time of his/her admission to the MS Management Degree program. It is agreed that all requirements established for the completion of the degree program must be fulfilled within seven (7) consecutive years to include the time at JFSC.

- 2. The Original Agreement is amended by adding a new Section 1.6 as follows:

1.6 The parties agree that the Transferred Credits described in Section 1.2 or Exhibit A apply to Program Participants entering the MS Management Degree program prior to UMUC's Fall 2005 semester. Effective from the Fall 2005 semester, UMUC shall grant a block of 15 Transferred Credits to Program Participants who have completed with a grade of at least 'B' or 'Pass' (i) either the Joint and Combined Staff Officer School (JCSOS) or the Joint and Combined Warfighting School (JCWS) programs prior to the JFSC curriculum change; or (ii) the JCWS resident seminar program. The Transferred Credits can be used only in satisfaction the Joint Military Strategy, Planning, and Decision Making specialty track in the MS Management Degree program.

- 3. The Original Agreement is amended by adding a new Section 1.7 as follows:

1.7 The parties agree that the requirements for earning the MBA degree set forth in Section 1.5 apply only to Program Participants who have been admitted to the MBA program prior to UMUC's Fall 2005 semester. The parties agree that UMUC may from time to time change the requirements for Program Participants for the MS in Management/MBA dual degree program. A Program Participant must satisfy the requirements in effect at the time of his/her

admission to the MS in Management Degree/MBA dual degree program.

4. Except as amended herein, the Original Agreement remains in full force and effect in accordance with its terms.
