SUBJECT: Reserve Retirement Points for the non-resident portion of Advanced Joint Professional Military Education (AJPME) and the Senior Enlisted Joint Professional Military Education (SEJPME) Distance Program

1. Ref (a) is the original JS assessment of AJPME directing awarding retirement point credit for completion of AJPME.

2. Based on curriculum changes resulting in increased contact and study hours, and per refs (b) thru (l), the Joint Forces Staff College (JFSC) recommends awarding the following retirement points for AJPME and SEJPME effective for classes completing on or after 7 October 2011;

- a. AJPME – 60 retirement points for completion of the 180-hour non-resident instruction.
- b. SEJPME – 15 retirement points for completion of the 45-hour distance education course.
