

International Officers Navy Gateway Inns and Suites Policy

As part of the acculturation process, all JPME students are provided quarters at JFSC. On base housing only, non-negotiable (including week-ins) both as a requisite for enrollment and potential for dis-enrollment if not adhered.

Dependents are not authorized.

Dependents of international military students are not authorized. Please contact imso@ndu.edu if you have any questions.

Navy Gateway Inns and Suites:

The Navy Gateway Inns and Suites billeting office is open 24 hours a day, 7 days a week. The quarters are furnished two or three bedrooms and each has a private, full bath. All suites have a fully equipped, shared, kitchen, as well as a full sized, shared, washer and dryer. Free wireless internet access is provided. Please ensure your computer has the ability to access a wireless network. All quarters are nonsmoking. Due to assignment policies, you may expect to share a unit with men and/or women of all Services as well as the Interagency.

The fees for quarters are:

\$56.00 for 04 and 05 and civilian equivalent

\$66.00 for 06 and civilian equivalent

\$76.00 for family housing

The Navy Gateway Inns and Suites accepts cash, check, Travelers Checks, American Express, Visa, MasterCard, and Discover credit card for payment.

Upon arrival, a means of payment must be provided to the billeting office; the Navy Gateway Inns and Suites office will document accordingly. Prior to the end of each month the Navy Gateway Inns and Suites billeting office will email each student, advising automatic room payments are due. At that time, there will be an opportunity to change the method of payment; otherwise, the original method provided will be used.

Students are permitted overnight guests on weekends and holidays only, at an additional charge of \$5 per person, per day. All visitors are to be approved and quarters arranged at the front desk prior to the guests' arrival. No more than two (2) guests allowed at any given time. Pets are not authorized under any circumstances.

Students must sign all billeting documentation with the Navy Gateway Inns and Suites Office. This will be acknowledgment of understanding the Navy Gateway Inns and Suites charged rates and policies regarding guests. Each document signed is an obligation to the charges rendered. Each student is fully responsible for paying the billeting account.
